

Division 1: Hunter Division

\$100 donation to enter entire division

Each horse will complete two over-fences courses comprised of 8 jumps (jump height approximately 2'3") and one under saddle flat class. The flat class will be broken up into flights should entries exceed a safe number.

Standard Tack Rules will apply

No draw reins, drop nosebands below the bit. Martingales with bit stops permitted over fences only. Ear plugs permitted. Only snaffle bits permitted.

Division 2: Flat Division

\$100 to enter entire division or \$50 donation per class

- Class 1: Dressage (English or Western tack)
 - Competitors will be asked to ride a Training Level test as downloaded from cadora.ca.
- Class 2: Flat Work (English or Western tack)
 - Horses will be judged on their gaits in a show hack/road hack style class.
- Class 3: Conformation
 - Horses will be judged on conformation, body condition, turnout, manners and overall disposition.

Standard Tack Rules Will Apply

No whips, drop nosebands, draw reins or martingales. Only snaffle bits permitted.

Division 3: Freestyle Class

\$50 donation to enter

Adopters must perform an original 3-4 minute routine with their graduate which will demonstrate the trainability and talent of the horse. Each entry will have 7 minutes total in the ring, 3 minutes to set up props and 3-4 minutes for the routine. Music is allowed and must be submitted prior to the event.

All horses must be either:

- ridden bareback
- ridden bridleless
- perform at liberty
- be driven or in long lines

All routines must contain the following compulsory movements:

- halt
- back up 4 paces
- figure 8 at the trot/jog
- canter/lope circle to both the left and right
